We will investigate the association between cannabis-related problems and other psychological problems. Psychological deviance as internalized and externalized disorder has shown to be associated to drug related problems. The purpose of the planned analysis is to investigate the relationship between psychological measures included as optional items in the ESPAD study (depressive mood, suicide attempts and antisocial behaviour) and cannabis-related problems in 9 countries (Belgium(Flanders), Bulgaria, Cyprus, Greece, Isle of Man, Latvia, Slovakia, United Kingdom)
