Suicide is the second most common cause of death in the age group of 15-35 years old in the WHO European region. Suicide attempts are closely related to deaths from suicide. This paper aims to examine the comparative role of various psychosocial factors in connection with self-reported suicide attempts in 16 year old adolescents from 17 European countries. The impact of sociocultural differences between countries on the prevalence of self reported suicide attempts and on the pattern of psychosocial factors associated with them will also be investigated.
