The effect of alcohol consumption on delinquency

Work Plan: (Please describe objectives, methods and specify the research question(s), maximum 250 words.) We want to investigate the effect of alcohol consumption on the illegal behavior. There are a few papers using data from the US that deal with this problem but there is hardly any evidence from European countries. We plan to use a sharp regression discontinuity design using the minimal legal drinking age laws across different countries to investigate the effect of alcohol consumption on the criminal activity of individuals. We will focus on countries with a minimum legal drinking age of 15 or 16 and check if being able to legally consume alcohol is associated with an increased rate of criminal activity.
