Cross-national stability of socioeconomic family background on adolescents' alcohol, tobacco and cannabis use

Work Plan: (Please describe objectives, methods and specify the research question(s), maximum 250 words.) It is well known that substance use is affected by socioeconomic factors. Associations between substance use and socioeconomic variables were found to vary between substances. It can be assumed that country-specific differences may play a role in explaining these inconsistencies.

We aim to examine to which extend associations between socioeconomic variables and use of alcohol, tobacco and cannabis vary across different European countries. Multilevel analyses will be applied, using sociodemographic variables (inter alia affluence and education variables) as first level predictors and country as second level predictor. Further country-level variables from secondary data sources will be considered. Criteria will be indicators of alcohol, tobacco and cannabis use.
