Aggressive behaviour among 15-16 year-old European high school students: results from two
consecutive surveys

Work Plan: (Please describe objectives, methods and specify the research question(s), maximum 250 words.)

The aim of the paper is to examine patterns of aggressive behaviour among 15-16 years-old European high school students, to compare data in two international representative samples and to identify possible associated factors for physical fight, autodestructive behaviours (family and social/peers environment and relationship, parental control, school attainment, perceived economic situation of family, tobacco, alcohol and drugs use, excessive drinking, persistence of use). The European School Surveys Project on Alcohol and Other Drugs (ESPAD) studies provide an opportunity to study aggressive behaviour in large interational samples 2007 and 2011. We want to compare Romanian data regarding aggressive behaviour (fighting, bullying, victimization, autodistructive) with data from other ESPAD participating countries.
