Research question(s):

1. Is there an association between polydrug use and suicide attempts?
2. Is the pattern of the association similar or different among different sociocultural contexts?

Objectives: To study the association between reported suicide attempts and polydrug use in different countries.

Method: Analysis to be based on survey data from school students in 18 ESPAD countries.

Polydrug use is defined as the use of more than two substances during lifetime and/or the last 30 days. Regression analysis methods will be applied to the data in order to examine the pattern of the association among different sociocultural contexts.
